- *Great Works Done*

Matt. 12:22, 28

- *Promised by Christ*

John 14:16, 17; 16:5-7

- *Revealed & Taught*

John 14:26; 15:26, 27; 16:13

- *Power*

Acts 1:8; 2:4, 43; Mark 16:20;  
Rom. 15:18, 19

- *Direction*

Acts 10:19; 16:6, 7

- **Regarding All Disciples:**

- ***Promised to All***

Acts 2:38, 39

- ***To Certain Individuals***

Luke 1:13-15, 41-45, 71ff

- ***Gifts to Some Disciples***

Acts 8:14-18; 19:6; 1<sup>st</sup> Cor. 12:1-11;  
Acts 10:44-47

- ***Direction & Instruction***

- to Some Disciples***

Luke 2:26, 27; Acts 8:29; 21:4;  
11:27, 28
