An Example to All

(v. 2)

- **Walks Uprightly**

- Because He Departs From Evil

PROV. 16:17

- Because He Feels the Lord

PROV. 14:2

- **Works Righteousness**

- He Hungers & Thirsts For It

MATT. 5:6

- The Lord and Righteousness

PSA. 11:7; PROV. 21:3



An Example to All

(v. 2)

- **Speaks Truth in His Heart**
 - Pure in Heart

PSA. 24:3, 4

- God's Law in His Heart

PSA. 37:30, 31; 119:11



Can Be Trusted By All

(v. 3)

- **Does Not Backbite**

- The Dangers of the Tongue

JAS. 3:3-8

- Instead, Will Speak Good Things

EPH. 4:25, 29

- **Does No Evil to His Neighbor**

- Does Not Instigate Trouble

PROV. 3:29

- Does Not Seek To Retaliate

ROM. 12:14-21



Can Be Trusted By All (v. 3)

- **Does Not Readily Bel. Accusations**
 - **Not Tolerating False Witnesses**

EXOD. 20:16

- **An Abomination to the Lord**

PROV. 6:19



Put's God Above All

(v. 4)

- **He Hates The Vile Person**

- Not the Person, But The Deeds

PROV. 8:13

- Necessary, to Please the Lord

PSA. 34:16; 119:101

- **He Honors the God-Fearing**

- With Brotherly Love

ROM. 12:10

- As Christ Loved Us

JOHN 13:34, 35; 1ST PET. 5:9



Puts God Above All

(v. 4)

- **Fulfills His Vows**

- **Foolish to Vow and Not Pay**

PROV. 20:25

- **No Going Back**

ECCL. 5:4, 5



Is A Friend To All

(v. 5)

- **Does Not Loan At Usury**
 - As God Demanded

LEV. 25:35-37

- Not Seeking To Be Repaid

LUKE 6:32-35

- **Does Not Take Bribes in Judgment**
 - The Character of God

DEUT. 10:17; 2ND CHR. 19:7

- He Seeks the Reward
