What Is 'Godliness'?

• Dictionary Definitions:

'The state of conforming to the laws and wishes of God.'

ROM. 12:1, 2

'To be God-like.'

MT. 5:48; JN. 15:12; 1ST COR. 11:1



• Bible Usage:

"Piety, reverence, loyalty, fear of God; only of the duty which man owes to God."

(Walter Bauer's Greek-English Lexicon)

"A particular manner of life characterized by reverence toward God and respect for the beliefs and practices related to him."

(Friberg's Analytical Lexicon of the Greek New Testament)
