### In The New Testament:

κοινωνία

A partnership; (implied) social relationship and sometimes, a financial sharing. κοινωνός

Companion; partner. μ∈τοξή

> Participation. ΚΟΙνωνέω

Partaker; sharing.

That is the "dictionary definition" but what does it mean in actuality?

In what do we share?
In what do we participate?

How can we have fellowship with one another?

We cannot have true fellowship with God *or* His people if we do not understand the nature of either!

The Nature Of God's People: Spiritual

Called His Children — Walking According to the Spirit (1st Cor. 3:1-4; Romans 8:1, 14)

Called His House — Offering Up Spiritual Sacrifices; A Dwelling Place of God in the Spirit

(1st Pet. 2:5; Eph. 2:21, 22; 1st Tim. 3:15)

Spiritual: *Blessings* ~ *Worship* ~ *Fight* (Eph. 1:3; John 4:24; Eph. 6:11-13/2<sup>nd</sup> Cor. 10:3-6)


