THE CONTEXT:

- THE LAW: 'EYE FOR AN EYE' EXOD. 21:23-25; LEV. 20:19, 20
 - WHAT WAS INTENDED: JUSTICE
 - WHAT IT HAD BECOME: AN ACT OF VENGEANCE

THE CONTEXT:

• THE LAW: 'LOVE YOUR NEIGHBOR'

LEV. 19:18

- A COMMAND TO LOVE...AND HATE?
- WHAT WAS FORGOTTEN
 PROV. 25:21, 22
- THE INTENT OF JESUS: A BETTER WAY MATTHEW 5:20

A ONE-MILE WORLD:

"...whoever slaps you...sues you...compels you...asks you..."

- THE WORLDLY STANDARD: ONE MILE...OR NONE
 - PERSONAL RIGHTS ARE THE PRIMARY FOCUS
 - BASICS AND MINIMUMS 'GOOD ENOUGH'

A ONE-MILE WORLD:

"...whoever slaps you...sues you...compels you...asks you..."

- PAYBACK IS THE RULE
 - A TWIST OF THE COMMAND
 - A PERVERSION OF GOD'S INTENT
- WHY, THEN, THIS COMMAND?

A SECOND-MILE CHURCH:

"Turn the other cheek...give your last garment...go the extra mile...love your enemies."

- DOES THIS 'MEAN WHAT IT SAYS'?
 - NO INFERENCE OF EXAGGERATION; YES!
 - HE DESIRES AN UNCOMMON RESPONSE
