## **Righteous Judgment** The Standard: God's Judgment – He Who Judges Righteously 1<sup>ST</sup> PETER 2:23 – No Unrighteousness in Him PSALM 92:15; 19:9

## **Righteous Judgment** Without Partiality – No Partiality With God **ROMANS 2:11; DEUT. 10:17** Partiality is Unacceptable to Him **JAMES 2:1-4,9**

## **Righteous Judgment** Not Hypocritically/Not Superficially – Hypocrisy Condemned MATTHEW 7:1-5; ROM. 2:1 – Man Known By His Heart 1<sup>ST</sup> SAM. 16:7; PROV. 27:19

## **Righteous Judgment** All Facts Must Be Considered – As God Does and Will 1<sup>ST</sup> COR. 4:1-5; 2<sup>ND</sup> COR. 5:10 - When Facts Cannot Be Determined...
