- I Have Divided Affections
  - / Try to Love God and the World

  - I Am Neither 'Good' Nor 'Bad'

- I Don't Want to 'Stand Out'
  - I Fear Ridicule and/or Persecution

— I Fear Damaged or Lost Relationships
